

Membership Rules

1. Any member equestrian club should be affiliated to the British Riding Clubs or their appropriate governing body.
2. A non member may use the facilities to ride a member's horse but the member must be present. A member may ride other peoples horses as long as the owner is a member.
3. Anyone having a lesson must be a member even if the person giving the lesson is a member.
4. If a member organises a training session all participants must be a member of Barstobrick but if a member club organises a training session the participants need not be members of Barstobrick must be members of an affiliated riding club, BHS or Pony Club. Individuals organising such sessions have no insurance cover.
5. Block bookings from individual members are to be discouraged, normally bookings will be taken up to 2 weeks in advance. A member, when booking, should be asked if they are prepared to share the area and F (flat work) or J (jumping) should be appended to the booking. This should improve availability and usage.
6. Liveries will be allocated 2 x 1hr for the whole yard together each week at a set time and there will be restrictions on the numbers who may ride together. Rules of working will be displayed. They may use the outdoor arena if it is not in use and they are members. At all other times they may book on the day only but must give way to a non livery member if requested.
7. Bookings by individual members should be limited to 1hr, especially evenings and weekends.
